

Tool Can Two

Supplies

Coffee Can

2 coordinating fabrics 17"x 26"

Batting 17"x 26"

Clear Vinyl 5"x 24"

3 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips WOF or Double Wide Bias Binding

& basic sewing supplies

Create a quilted sandwich from coordinating fabrics and batting. Trim to 15"x 24".

Press strips in half WOF for 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " folded strip, open and fold WOF raw edges to center and press. Fold in half again and press. Or use Double Wide Folded Bias Binding.

Bind one long side of vinyl, (Lay edge of vinyl into fold on binding, so binding covers front and back, stitch in place). I used Bernina foot #52D and stitch #4. When working with Teflon feet use tissue paper over feed dog areas that foot may come in contact with.

Match three raw edges of vinyl and quilted top. Baste 1/8" around raw edges. Sew "pockets", recommended widths 2"- 4". Recommend #6 stitch, reinforce stitches at "pocket" tops.

Bind top and bottom, 24" lengths. Fold top over 4", pin, baste edges in raw edges in place. Sew pockets as mentioned above.

Bind raw sides edges. Fold over coffee can, some scrounging may be needed, fill with accessories.

You may wish to add a stitch line on some pockets for shorter items.
